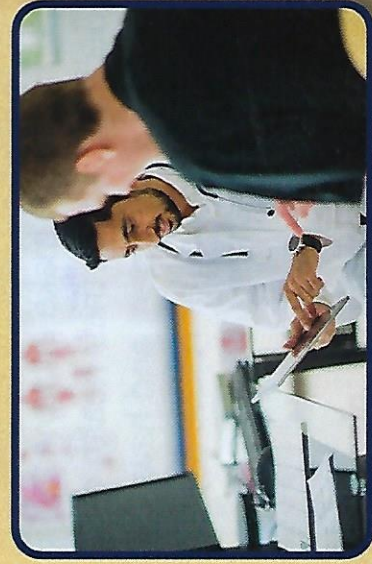

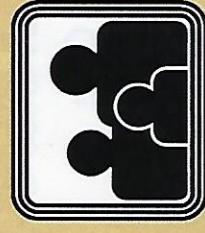

Everyone is welcome at our health centers. We accept most managed care plans, and we offer uninsured patients payment options on a sliding fee scale.

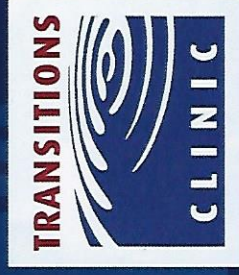

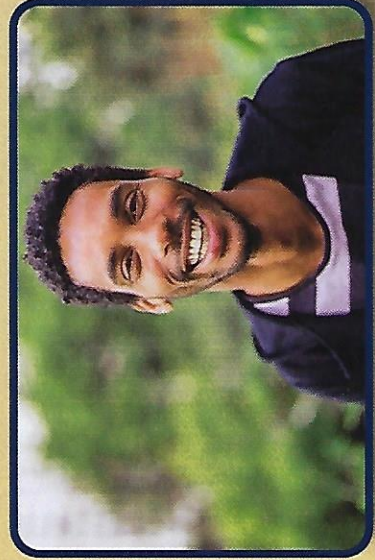

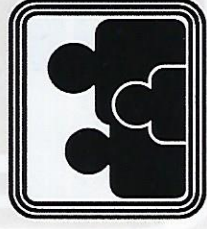
FHCSD's Community Health Worker, a trained professional who also has a history of incarceration, will assist and support you with:
